Multiple Coronavirus Bills COVID-19 Testing and Prevention

Total Amount: \$14.7 Billion

Description

- Enacted in P.L. 116-123 Coronavirus Preparedness and Response Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2020 (\$2.2 billion) on March 6, 2020, P.L. 116-136 Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act (\$1.5 billion) on March 27, 2020, and P.L. 116-139 Paycheck Protection Program and Health Care Enhancement Act (\$11 billion) on April 24, 2020.
- Provides \$14.7 billion in direct assistance to states, territories, and tribal governments to prevent, prepare for, and respond to COVID-19. This includes increasing testing and analysis of COVID-19 and tracking the spread of the virus. According to currently available data (as of May 18, 2020), approximately \$13 billion in funding had been distributed.
- Funding allocation is determined two ways. The first is formula-based and determined by the relative number and “hotspots” of COVID-19 cases. Second, the Department of Health and Human Services and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention have discretion to allocate funding to states based on need.
