CARES Act Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) Grants

Total Amount: \$900 Million

Description

- Enacted in P.L. 116-136 Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act on March 27, 2020.
- Provides \$900 million in additional LIHEAP funding to states (\$882.5 million), territories including the District of Columbia (\$7.3 million), and tribal governments (\$10.2 million) for energy assistance for low-income individuals.
- Allocation is based on the formula for distributing funds under the LIHEAP program, which considers the population and weather of each state or territory.
