Families First Coronavirus Response Act UI Emergency Administrative Grants

Total Amount: \$1 Billion

Description

- Enacted in P.L. 116-127 Families First Coronavirus Response Act on March 18, 2020.
- Provides \$1 billion in grants to states and the territories for administration of unemployment insurance (UI) programs.
- Each state's allocation is calculated by multiplying its proportionate share of taxable wages, under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act, by \$1 billion.
