CARES Act Homeless Assistance Emergency Solutions Grants

Total Amount: \$4 Billion

Description

- Enacted in P.L. 116-136 Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act on March 27, 2020.
- Provides \$4 billion in supplemental funding to states and territories, including the District of Columbia, for homeless assistance grants.
- Allocation is based on the current Emergency Solutions Grants formula, in addition to a formula determined by the Department of Housing and Urban Development Secretary which considers factors such as the risk of coronavirus spread, housing market conditions, and an area's homeless population.
